Circumcision is a surgery which usually performed for religious purposes. Circumcision is perceived by our society as a simple surgical operation but in fact it is an extremely important procedure. When carried out by non-competent or careless surgeon; very important complications can occur. During circumcision in patients with phimosis, when phimosis is not properly corrected, penile glans amputation can occur during especially with giotin method.

In our case, the patient had penile glans amputation that underwent circumcision at another center. They told to the patient and family as when the child grows penile glans will regenerate. Patient therefore remained unmarried and expected penile glans to regenerate. Later on when any regeneration does not occur the patient was admitted to our center demanding redoing a new penile glans

CONCLUSION: Circumcision is a surgical intervention performed on the penis which is an important organ for men. If this is not done properly it can lead to a number of serious complications. For that reason circumcision must be performed by skilled surgeons.
